A full year of training in clinics and hospitals affiliated with the Faculty of Dentistry, during which the graduate spends a supervised training session to complete the requirements of the stage.

Admission Requirements

- The student must have obtained a secondary education certificate in the scientific stream from one of the Libyan schools or an equivalent certificate recognized by the competent authority.
- The student must have obtained the percentage approved for admission to the faculty according to the systems defined by the Ministry of Education (secondary education 85% at least).
